## Frequently Asked Questions



Q. When does camp start and end each day?

A. Preschool Camp runs from 9am to 12pm. Full day camp runs from 9am to 3:00pm.

Q. Where do I register my age 4 and 5 year old?

A. Campers aged 4 and 5 have the option to register half day or full day.

Q. What should my child(ren) bring for the day?

A. Each child should bring a water bottle, hat, sunscreen, extra clothes if necessary for the child, a PEANUT/NUT free lunch.

Q. What is the cost of your camp?

A. Half-day Preschool Camp costs \$40.00. Full-day camp costs \$100.00.

Q. Do you provide lunch?

A. No, Campers need to bring a PEANUT/NUT free lunch every day. Morning and afternoon snacks will be provided.

Q. Do you have a discount for multiple children?

A. Families with three or more children will receive a 25% discount on all the children.

Q. Is financial assistance available?

A. We want each child to have the opportunity to attend our Harvest Summer Kids Camp. If you require financial assistance, please email [sboyes@harvestdurham.ca](mailto:sboyes@harvestdurham.ca).

Q. What is your cancellation policy?

A. You may cancel your registration with no penalty before June 15, 2015. After June 15, 2015, you will be charged a \$25 cancellation fee.

Q. Do you have before/after camp care?

A. We do not offer before or after camp care. Please contact Susan Boyes at [sboyes@harvestdurham.ca](mailto:sboyes@harvestdurham.ca) if you wish to make arrangements

Q. Can my child be grouped together with a friend?

A. We will make every effort to place friends in the same morning group.

Not all requests will be possible. In order for your child(ren) to be grouped together with a friend, they must register for the same elective.

Q. Can I buy an extra t-shirt for my child?

A. Extra t-shirts, in limited quantities, will be on sale for \$7 each on the second day of camp at the registration desk.

Q. What will happen if there is an emergency involving my child?

A. In the case of an emergency, every effort will be made to first reach the parent/guardian that we have on file. If we aren't able to reach the parent/guardian, we will then call the emergency contact.

Q. My child has allergies. How do you handle that?

A. Each Elective Leader will have a roster that lists the allergies of each child. All snacks provided during the day will be peanut/nut free. If your child is allergic to other foods, please send an appropriate snack with them each day.

Q. Is my child allowed to bring their electronic device to camp?

A. We suggest that all ipods/phones/electronics stay at home. We will not assume responsibility for any lost/stolen/broken items during our week of camp.
